The Progressions are narrative documents describing the progression of a topic (strand) across a number of grade levels, informed both by educational research and the structure of mathematics. These documents were used as the basis for grade level standards. They offer some guidance but not complete guidance about how topics might be sequenced and approached across and within grades. In this respect, the Progressions are an intermediate step between the Standards and a teacher's classroom implementation. They note key connections among standards, point out cognitive difficulties and pedagogical solutions, and give more detail on particularly knotty areas of the mathematics. As with any written mathematics, understanding the Progressions may take time and discussion with others. If you are working on curriculum alignment you may find a study of the Progressions useful.
